- Commit to daily contemplative prayer.
- Visit the sick, imprisoned, and homeless.
- Feed the hungry and clothe the naked.
- Provide spiritual companionship and emotional support to those who feel isolated, rejected, discriminated against and marginalized.

"At the heart of our mission is the understanding that love is not merely an ideal—it is an action," said Fr. Séamus of Jesus, founder of the Carmelite Missionaries of Merciful Love in Action. "We seek to reflect the merciful heart of Christ through lives of contemplative prayer and intentional service."

A New Carmelite Rule of Life:

The order will adopt a contemporary Discalced Carmelite Rule of Life based on the ancient Carmelite Rule of St. Albert that emphasizes the Beatitudes and the Gospel call to love one another as Christ loves us. Members will be contemplatives in the world, balancing prayer, community life, and ministry to those in need. The order will welcome priests, deacons, religious brothers and sisters, and laypersons who feel called to live the Carmelite charism.
